




Averted School Violence (ASV) Database

ASV houses more than 300 cases of violence averted, lives saved, and lessons learned in prevention. More than 1,600 persons currently subscribe to the database.

The ASV project receives funding from the Motorola Solutions Foundations.



By studying averted school attacks, we can better identify failure points in safety systems, recognize promising policies and practices, invest wisely, and prevent future attacks.



At the request of JustCommunity New Zealand, Safe and Sound Schools built a team of national and international experts in mass violence response and recovery to inform the Christchurch Coroner's Inquest.





2019 Christchurch Mosque Shooting After-Action Report

- In addition to the written report, the team leads from the U.S. and U.K. teams testified for two days during the Inquest and the teams continue to provide support to the ongoing Inquest.
- Safe and Sound Schools helped answer questions raised by the families of those killed and injured during the mosque attacks and identified lessons learned and best practices to inform the prevention and response to future attacks in New Zealand.
