NOTES

Keck Center: Is located at 500 Fifth St. NW, in Washington's Penn Quarter district, adjacent to Judiciary Square and the Verizon Center. The closest Metro stations are Gallery Place/Chinatown (Red, Green and Yellow lines; take "7th and F St." exit and turn left) and Judiciary Square (Red line; take National Building Museum exit and turn left). Keck Security/ID required: Meeting attendees entering the building will need to show a photo ID to the Security Guard, who checks the ID against the attendee list.

Keck Parking: There is plenty of free parking in the Keck Center's underground lot. Access to the lot is off of Sixth Street (between E and F Streets).

Wi-Fi Connection: To connect to the Wi-Fi choose "Visitor Network" then open up a browser and click "Accept terms and conditions." You will then be connected to the internet.
