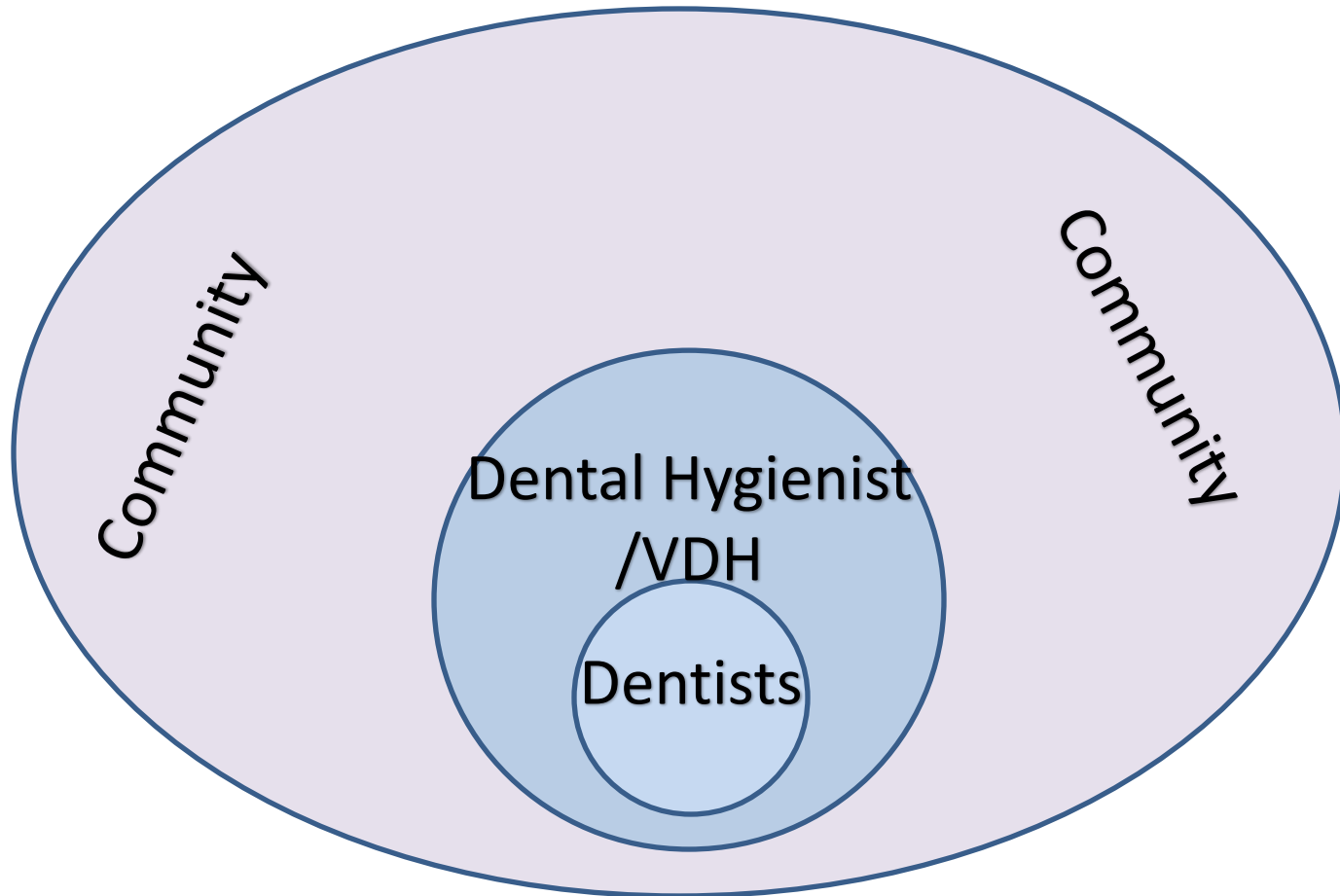
Sophisticated but high cost surgical suite
– Not accessible for most people



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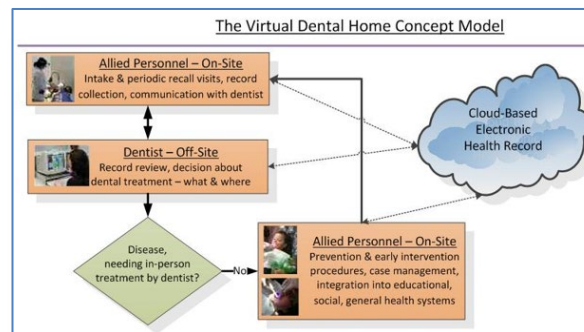
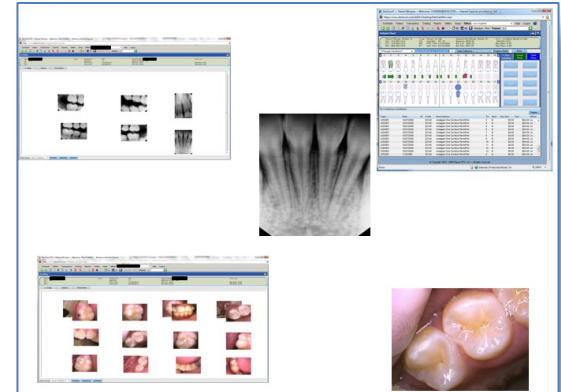

 - Parents get report with photographs
 - Data in electronic database can be used for:
 - Referral
 - Follow up
 - Reporting
 - Continuum of care

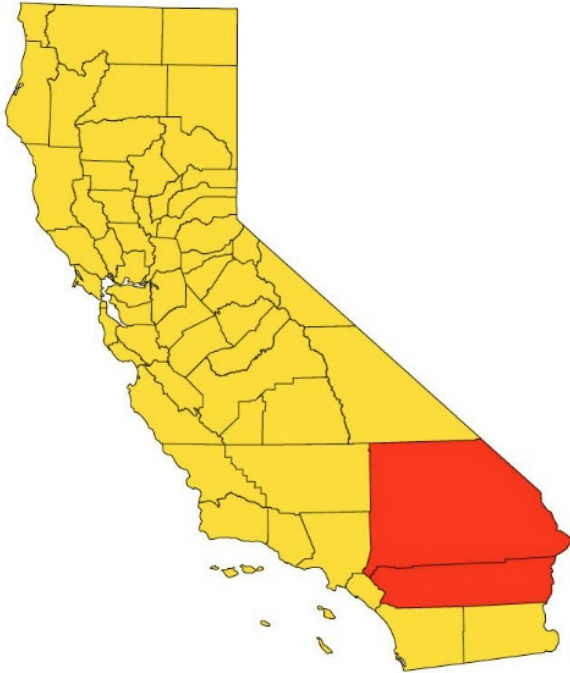




Home Visitors at the Front End of an Oral Health System

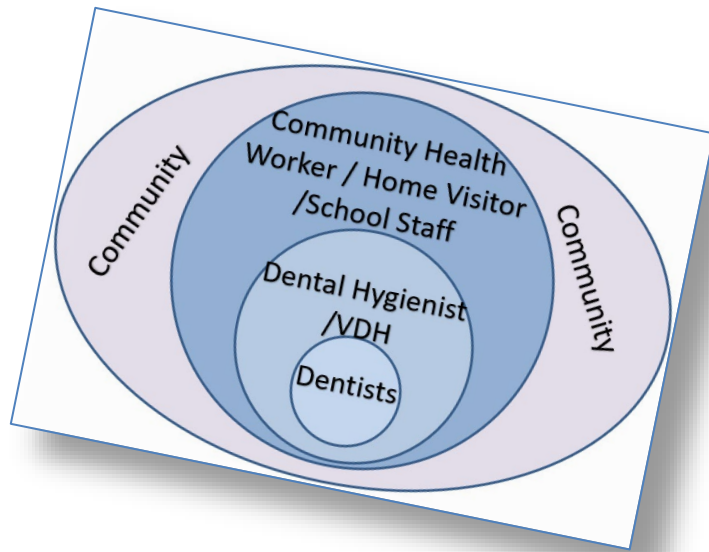

Findings

- Home visitors:
 - Can perform risk assessment >1000 assessments
 - Are enthusiastic about new knowledge and tools
- Can provide effective education and support for parents for adoption of mouth healthy habits
- Can help focus care management and referral resources on those most at risk
- Can apply Fluoride Varnish

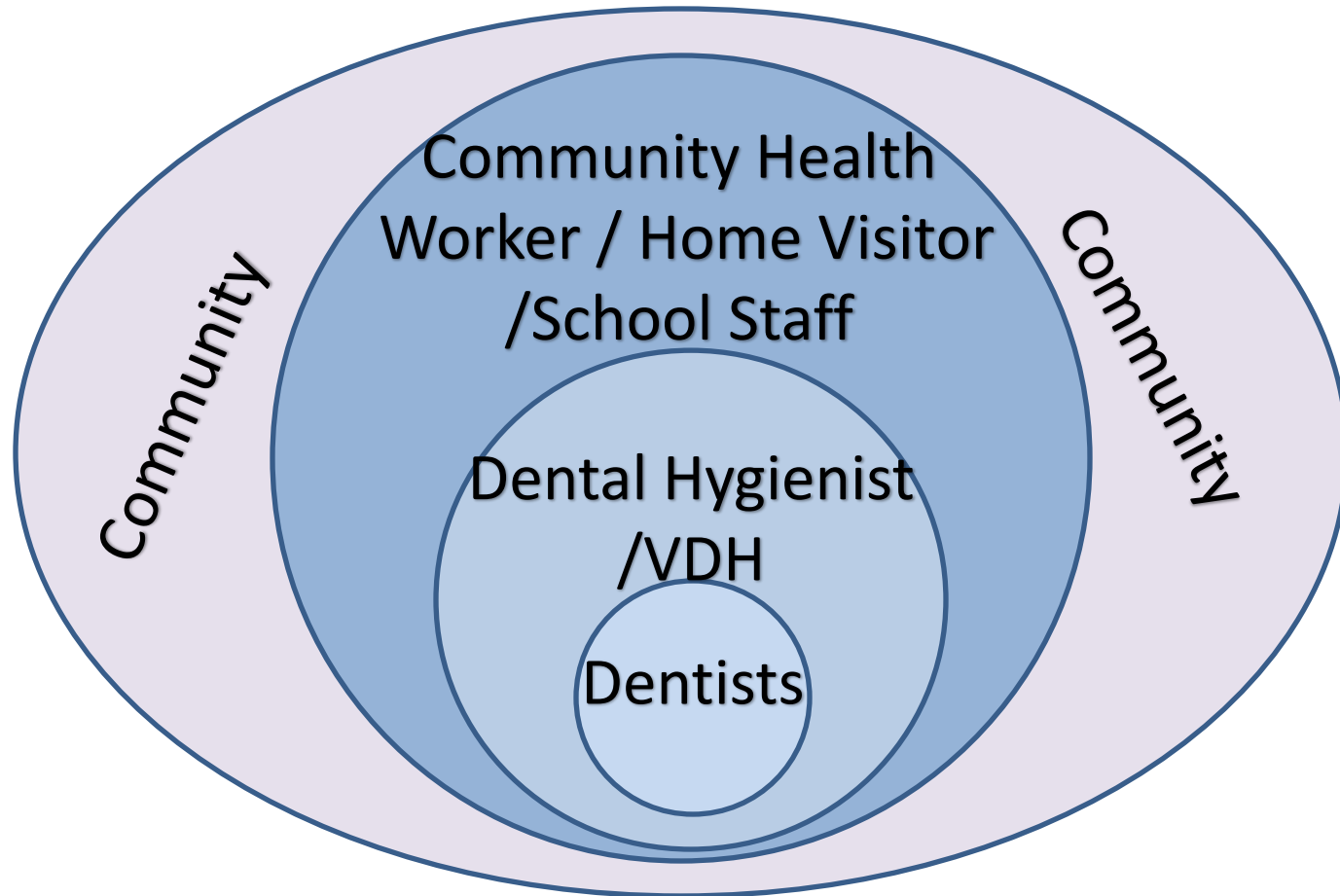
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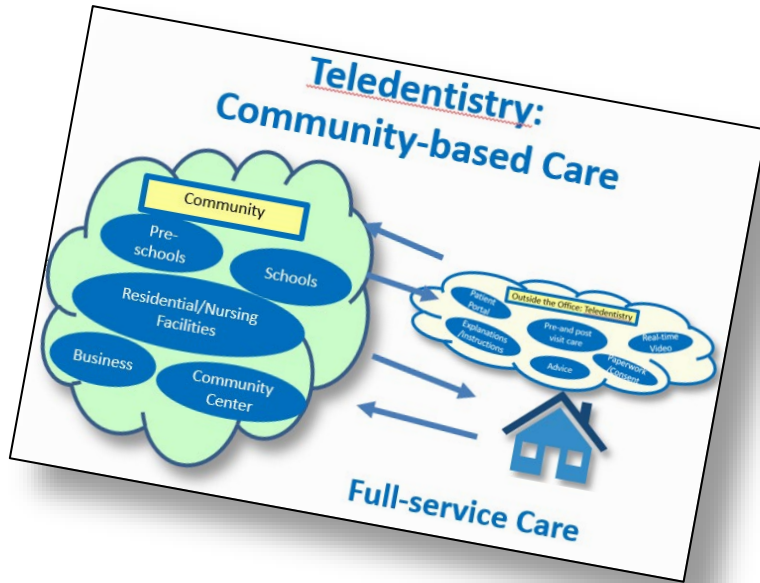


- Expect 50 % reduction in people needing sedation/ GA for dental care

- Savings in cost, and consequences of current system

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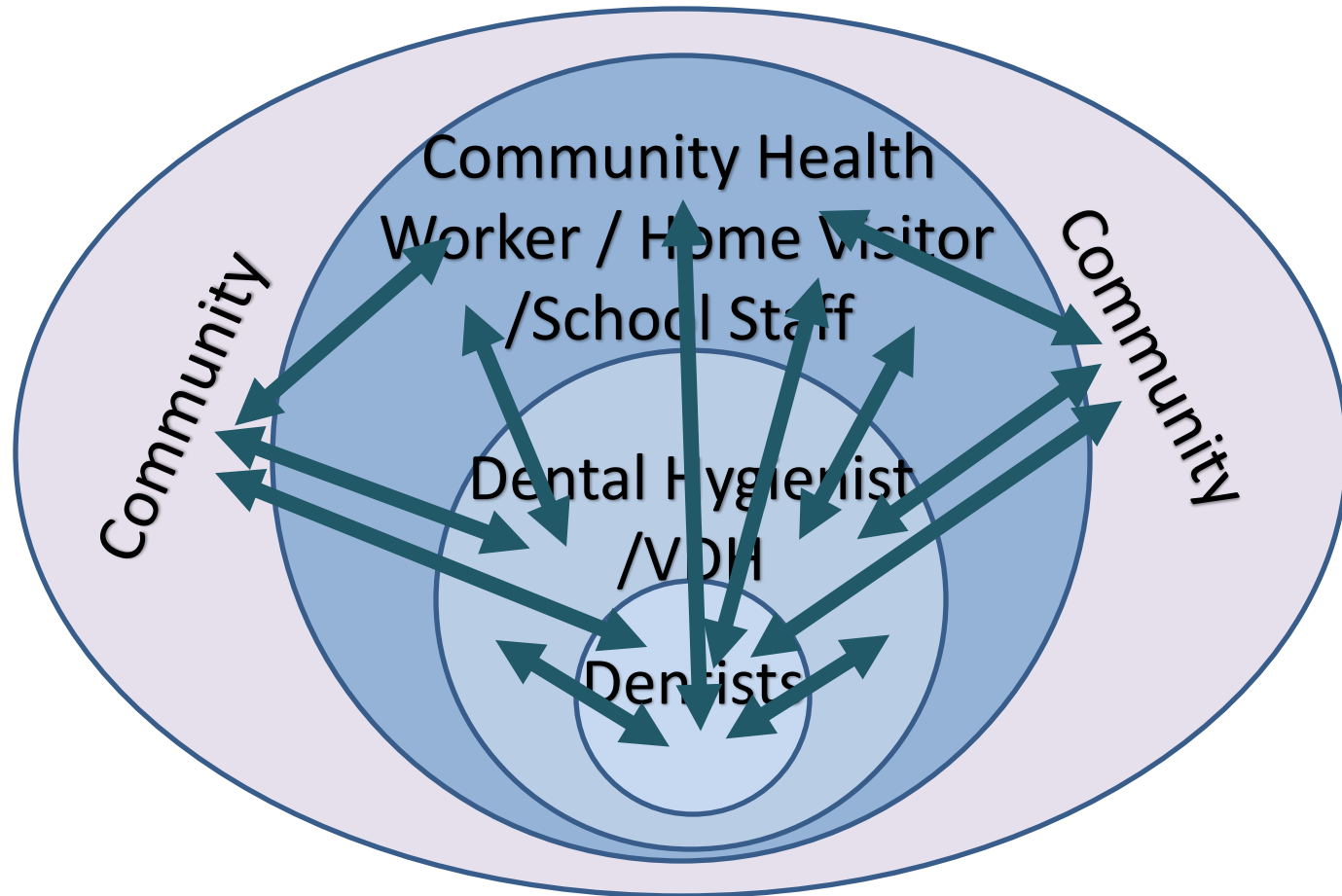
