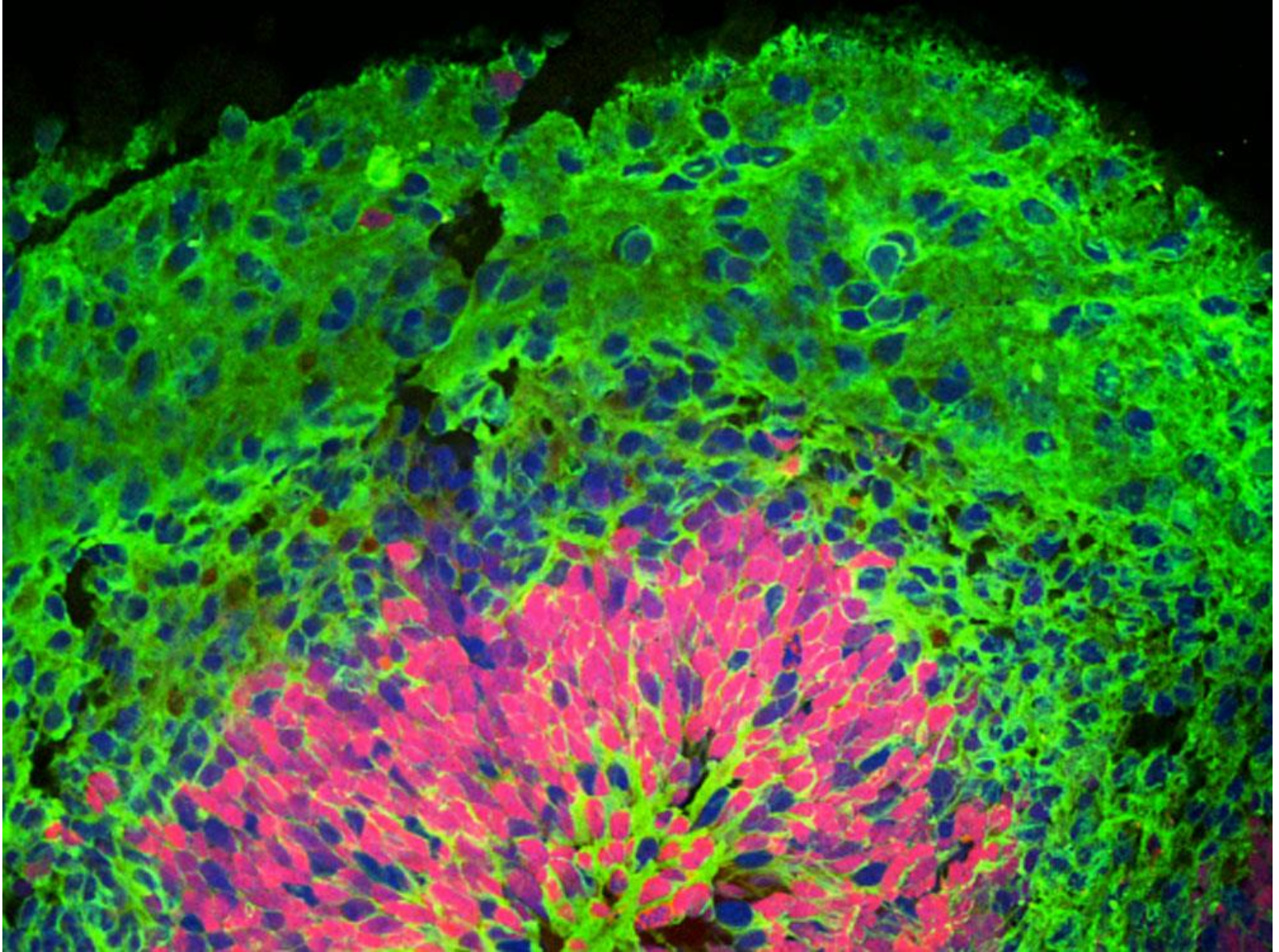

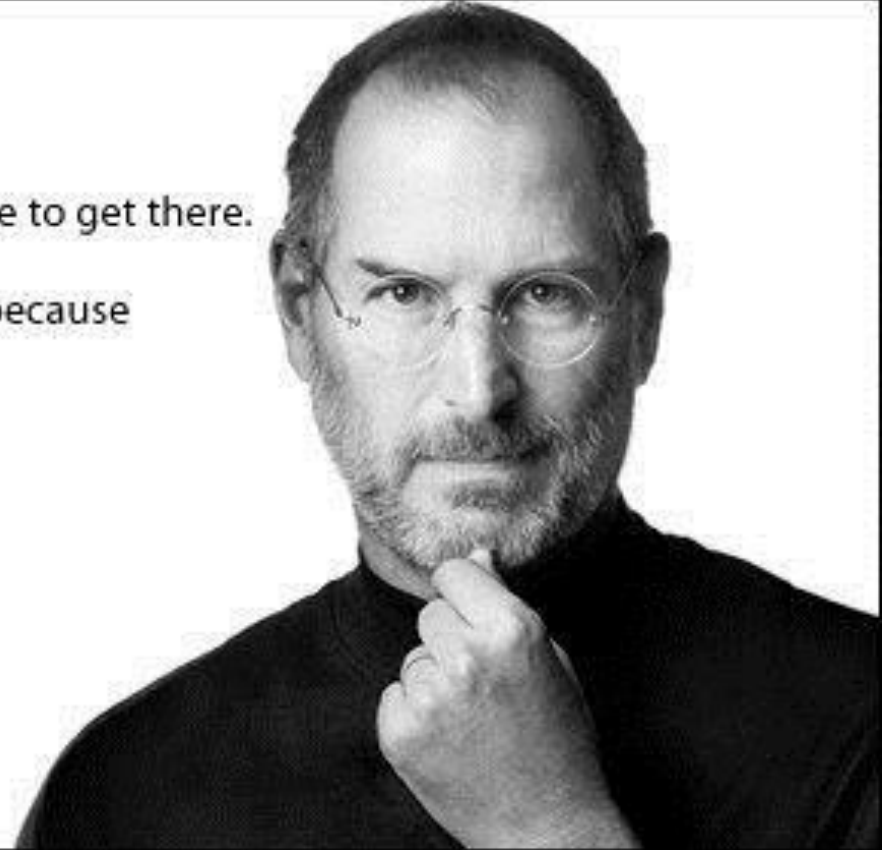
On Death and Dying

No one wants to die.

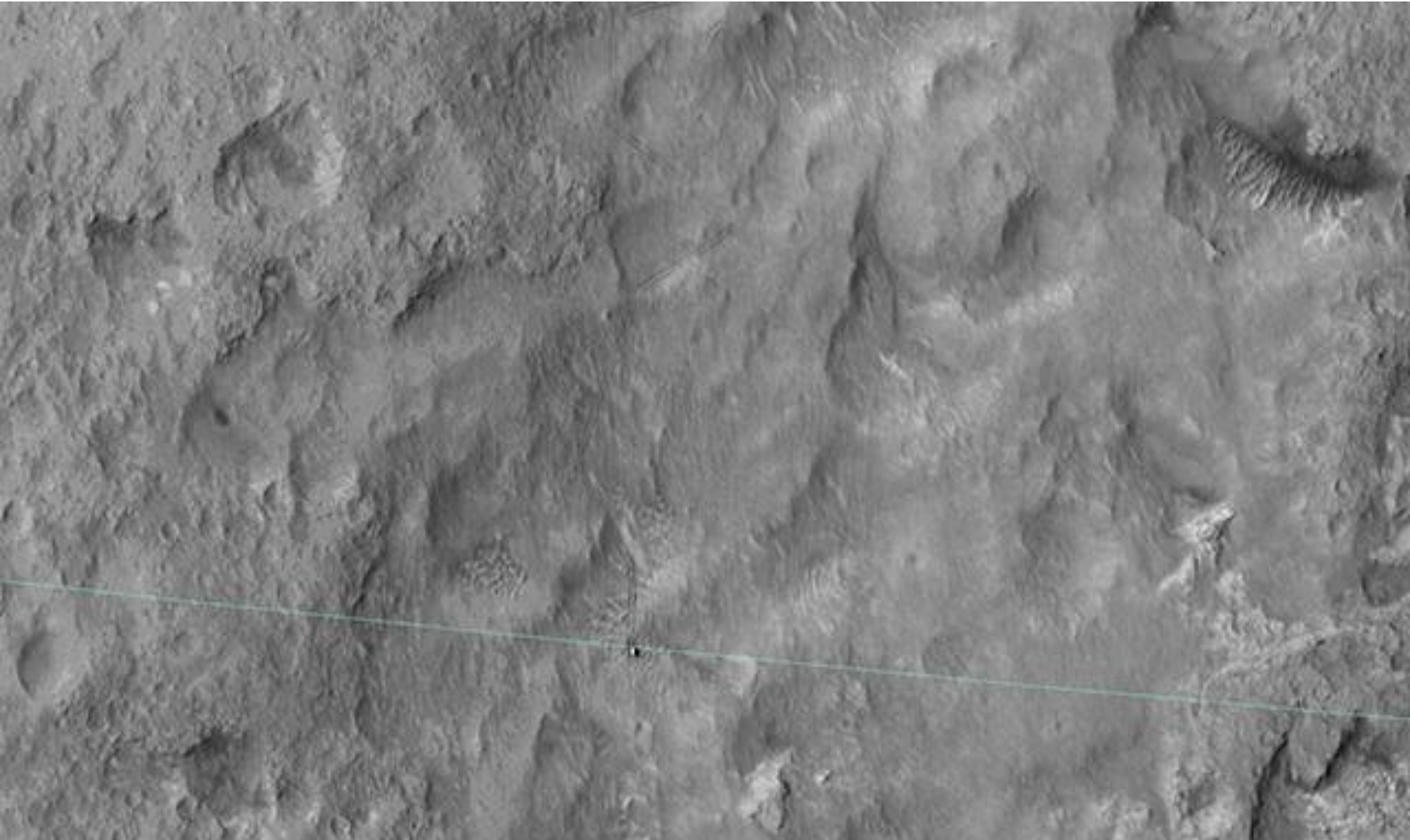
Even people who want to go to heaven don't want to die to get there.
